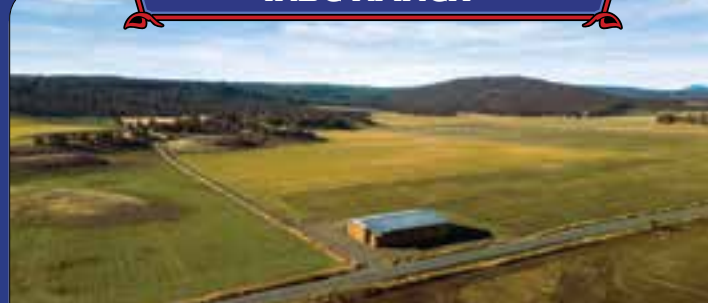

BULL AND HEIFER TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- 1. Date of Sale:** February 1, 2025
 - 2. Place of Sale:** Klamath County Fairgrounds.
 - 3. Terms of Sale:** Cash, Check or Credit Card (3% fee).
 - 4. Bidding:** This sale is without reserve or pass-out, provided however the right to bid is reserved for all consignors and their agents, unless otherwise announced. Each animal will be sold to the highest bidder without reserve. There will be no by-bidding. Any phone or mail bids to the auctioneer or ring men will be announced when bull or heifers are sold. The auctioneer in charge will settle any disputes as to bids and his decision on such matters will be final.
 - 5. Liability:** Although every possible precaution will be exercised to protect the safety and comfort of guests of the sale neither the Association nor its representatives, nor the auctioneers or clerks, assume any liability for accidents. All warranties are made between buyer and seller, not the sale management.
 - 6. Purchasers Risk:** Each animal will be at purchaser's risk as soon as sold. All cattle must be removed from Fairgrounds no later than Sunday, February 2, 2025 by 5:00 pm.
 - 7. Sifted Animals:** All bulls & heifers barred from the sale may be sold private treaty. There is a commission to the Committee owed by consignor. In such an event the Sale Committee will not accept any responsibility for the future condition or performance of such animals.
- BULLS**
- 8. Age of Bulls and Minimum Weight Per Day Requirement:** Bulls must have been born after Dec 1, 2022 and before Feb 1, 2024, and meet minimum weight per day of age requirements. Bulls must also have minimum 34 cm scrotal measurement.
 - 9. Bull Registration:** Only bulls registered by their respective breed associations will be sold.
 - 10. Health Requirements:** Bulls have been tested for Trichomoniasis and PI-BVD (bulls originating from a designated

Brucellosis surveillance area have been tested free of Brucellosis within 60 days of the Sale). Each Bull will have an individual health certificate at the time of purchase. All bulls have been vaccinated by consignors.

- 11. Semen Test:** Bulls were semen tested within sixty (60) days of the sale and must be designated as a Satisfactory Potential Breeder by a licensed veterinarian or CSS technician.
- 12. Rule on All Non - Breeding Bulls:** Bulls have been semen tested. However, buyers suspecting a bull purchased during the Klamath Bull & Heifer Sale to be an unsatisfactory potential breeder must notify the Klamath Bull & Heifer Sale Committee regarding such bull within **FOURTEEN DAYS OF THE DATE OF THE SALE**. The Klamath Bull & Heifer Sale Committee will then have an examination and investigation made by a competent veterinarian. The Committee reserves the right to call in their own veterinarian if they deem it necessary. They will consider exceptional cases. If it is determined that the bull is a non-breeder, consignor will be required to either compensate the buyer of the difference between beef value of the bull and the purchase price, or return the entire purchase price to the buyer and take the bull back at his own expense. If the buyer wishes a replacement and consignor is willing to settle in this manner it will be satisfactory to the Klamath Bull & Heifer Sale Committee.

HEIFERS

- 13. Age of Heifers:** Heifers must be weaned, vaccinated and palpated or ultra-sounded by vet to be determined open and satisfactory potential to be bred. Heifers are greater than 7 months old and less than 15 months old and open.
- 14. Health Requirements:** Heifers have been Bangs vaccinated, have a negative PI-BVD test and have been vaccinated by consignors.
- 15.** Heifers will be sold in pens of 3 and are uniform in nature.

Hammer Ranch- Derek and Amanda Hammer H^H

Crane, Oregon

Owners of the Hammer Ranch and first generation cattle and horse ranchers out of Crane, Oregon, Derek and Amanda Hammer, found themselves in need of bulls, a bunch of them. They had just bought a herd of cattle to go on a new Forest Service permit they had acquired in the John Day country. That is how they became the high volume buyer at the 2024 Klamath Bull Sale.

Their story, a bit of a fairytale, started when Amanda, met Derek at a family birthday party at Mark and Cathy Ferguson's, our very own Mark and Cathy who sell bulls every year at the Klamath Bull Sale.

Derek who had been raising cattle with his uncle had a dream of owning a ranch and Derek and Amanda moved forward to fulfill that plan. Starting with raising ranch trained working horses and adding a few head of cattle on a regular basis, their dream began to take shape and grow in small measures. They moved to the Crane area south of Burns in 2012 and bought a ranch where they grow their own hay and base their operations.

In 2014 Amanda roped him in and they tied the knot. They have 2 children, Taylor Rose (9) and Justin (7) who

are their top performing hands. This last fall when Amanda broke her arm and was out of commission, the kids stepped up to the chute and took over in the Fall gather. "They did an outstanding job filling mom's boots." shared Derek.

They came to the bull sale last year looking for a couple of low birthweight bulls and some bulls to add carcass growth qualities to their burgeoning herd. They lean towards red and also black baldy types in their commercial cow/ calf herd where they run between their deeded acreage on the desert and the forest permit in the mountains. The Hammers had bought bulls from JSL Angus, Mark and Cathy's ranch in Madras, Oregon in previous years and liked the results so they climbed on board when Mark's bulls entered the ring, snapping up two of their favorites. They also added to the trailer load with bulls from Bianchi Ranches, Traynham Ranches and Bar-N-Bar Angus.

As I wrapped up our interview Derek added, "Being first generation ranchers we have relied heavily on good neighbors and we have been fortunate to be surrounded by many. The Good Lord has put things in play for us and that has made all the difference."

Our scholarship program was put in place for that very reason, helping the next generation fulfill their hopes and ambitions in the ag world. CAUTION: Federal law restricts this drug to use by or on the order of a licensed veterinarian.

INDICATIONS:

VALCOR™ is indicated for the treatment and control of the following species of parasites in beef cattle two months of age and older and in replacement dairy heifers less than 20 months of age. Not for use in beef bulls intended for breeding over 1 year of age, dairy calves, and veal calves.

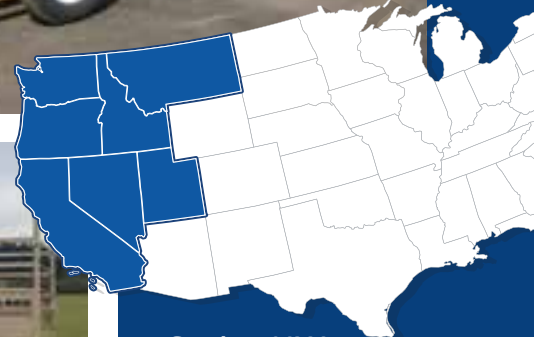
